Online Application are invited from Indian Citizens (as defined in Article 5 of the Constitution of India) of the State of Meghalaya for recruitment to the following technical posts in the Krishi Vigyan Kendras under the Department of Agriculture as the Host Organization on contract basis. The applicants will have to appear for a Written Test for the post No 1-3 and Candidates who qualify in the Written Test will need to appear in a Personal Interview before the Selection Committee, duly constituted for the purpose by the State Government and for the post No-4 the eligible applicants will have to appear in a Personal Interview only before the Selection Committee, duly constituted for the purpose by the State Government. Candidates canvassing directly or indirectly shall be disqualified

Terms & Conditions: -


1. **Age Limit:-** 18 years to 27 years relaxable by 5 (five) years in respect of Candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribes as per State Government's reservation policy.

2. **Conditions of appointment for the post No 1-3:-**

- (i) The posts are co-terminus with the project and will cease as and when Govt. of India terminates the project.
- (ii) The scale of pay as adopted by the ICAR for all KVKs in the country shall be considered for the posts mentioned.
- (iii) The terms and conditions for service under the KVKs will be governed by ICAR norms as per "**Memorandum of Understanding**" agreed upon by ICAR, New Delhi and the State Department of Agriculture.
- (iv) Applicants already in Govt. Service should apply through proper channel.
- (v) The written examination shall comprise of 100 marks for the technical subject and 50 marks for General Knowledge and 50 marks for General English. Questions will be objective, subjective & multiple choice questions.

3. **Conditions of appointment for the post No-4**

- (i) The posts is on Contractual basis co-terminus with the **Gramin Krishi Mausam Sewa(GKMS) scheme** on year to year extension basis and based on review of annual performance.
 - (ii) The scale of pay for the Post of Subject Matter Specialist – SMS (Agro-meteorology) working at KVK in the scale of Scientist 'B' i.e Rs. 15600-39100 (G.P. Rs. 5400) as per 6th CPC or 7th CPC Prorata on contractual basis.
 - (iii) The terms and conditions for service under the KVKs will be governed by India Meteorology Department (IMD) norm as per "**Memorandum of Understanding**" agreed upon by IMD & ICAR, New Delhi.
 - (iv) Preference will be given to candidates with Post-Graduation degree in Agrometeorology .
