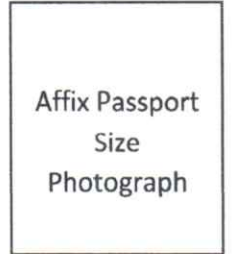

- a). Residential certificate from competent authority. (Self Attested)
- b). Educational Qualification (SSLC) Certificate. (Passed certificate & mark sheet of class X is compulsory) (Self Attested)
- c). ST/SC certificate (Self Attested)
- d). Birth Certificate. (Self Attested)
- e). EPIC. (Self Attested)
- f). Bank Pass Book, copy of first page of trainee's own functional Bank Savings Account (Self Attested).
- g). Two (2) nos. of Passport size photographs & 1(one) Stamp Size photograph.
- h). Land Document (*please refer to Sl. No.14 of the application form*)
- i). Medical fitness certificate from respective PHC/CHC (Original)
- j). AADHAAR Card. (Self Attested).
- k) Unemployment Certificate: Unemployment status of a candidate may be included in Recommendation letter issued by the respective District Level Officers of the Department of Agriculture and Farmers' Welfare. Alternatively a self certification by a candidate duly endorsed by any Gazetted Officer may also be accepted.



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Terms & Conditions of the Training Programme.

1. All the trainees will have to stay in the hostel of the Training Centre during the entire training period.
2. Minimum of 90% attendance will be required for attending the training.
3. All the trainees will have to abide by all the rules and regulations of the Training Centre.
4. Seed Money will be disbursed to the passed out trainees in installments i.e, 50:50 based on the progress of work/activities opted along with the recommendation of the concerned mentors.
5. If for any reason, seed money is not properly utilized for the purpose for which it is meant or the project/activity remain incomplete or stopped mid way, the concerned passed out Trainee will have to refund all the amount he/she has received.
6. Timely evaluation as arranged by the office of the Principal Basic Agricultural Training Centre, Upper Shillong will be conducted for the purpose of monitoring, encouraging and maximizing the success rate of the passed out trainee.
7. If for any reason, a trainee leaves or discontinues the training programme he/she shall not be eligible to receive the seed money and the authority reserves the right to select the next candidate from the waiting list.
8. The trainee has to submit Land Document in case he/she opts for Farm based activities.



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Description of the Training Programme

1. The training of the TREYSEFA includes classroom lecture, practical & exposure/field visit within the state.
2. The course in general covers the Agricultural, Horticultural background including the allied sector.
3. The duration of the training programme is 2 (two) months for each batch.
4. The total number of trainees to be selected for each batch is 20 (twenty).
5. The selected applicants will be intimated for attending the training at the Office of the Principal Basic Agricultural Training Centre, Upper Shillong as per final decision of the Screening Committee.
6. The training program is purely residential wherein free accommodation in dormitory along with fooding will be provided free of cost.
7. Stipend for the TREYSEFA trainees will be disbursed by the Training Centre through online mode (DBT/NEFT/etc).
8. Seed money will be disbursed to the TREYSEFA trainees through online mode (DBT/NEFT/etc) on their completion of the training to enable him/her to start up with their business/enterprise.

Eligibility Criteria:-

1. The applicant should be minimum SSLC passed & with a minimum age of **25(twenty five) to 40(Forty) years.**
2. The selected youth should have his/her own or parents' land that will be made available to him/her for implementation of his/her opted project/ activity after completion of the training programme, wherever the activity opted for requires land.



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
